Frequently Asked Questions

1

Am I able to register for the ID camp if my team is not participating in the Showcase or Tournament?

Yes, the ID Camp provides the flexibility of individual player attendance, with or without your team participating in our weekend events.

Is there a selection process in determining acceptance to ID Camp?

No, players are accepted based on the number of available spots at time of application.

Does the ID Camp offer positional based sessions (ie. GK)?

Yes, goalkeepers will have dedicated training and will also be incorporated into field player sessions.

How are the School's selected that run the sessions?

University and Colleges are selected primarily from the USA, with inclusion of select Canadian Universities. University and Colleges are primarily NCAA Division I, however there is representation from all athletic associations: USA (NCAA and NAIA) and Canada (U Sports). For USA University and Colleges, we select institutions with a large roster of Canadian and International players, as this is an indicator of the institutions ability to recruit Canadians.

What is the ratio of players to coach?

There are 15 Players to 1 Coach. However, players will train with all coaches.

I am only able to attend one day, am I still able to register?

As a general rule, no. We encourage all to register for the entirety of the event to provide you the best opportunity at exposure to college recruits.

Will there be training staff on site for me to get treatment (ie. taping) before a session?

Yes, we will have Athletic Therapists on site. Players that require treatment or taping should arrive 30 minutes prior to their scheduled session (at minimum).

Will we receive information about those schools that are attending as ID Camp field instructors in advance of the Thursday/Friday?

University and College have been posted on our website and will be updated leading up to the ID Camp.
